## SACRAMENT OF PENANCE DURING LENT

*Daily: Monday-Friday—7:30 a.m.*

*Saturday: 3:00—3:45 p.m.*

*Sunday: 10:45– 11:30 a.m.*



The most important thing is not to “go to confession,” but **“to make a good confession,”** i.e.,

1. to approach this sacrament sincerely sorry for our sins;
2. to confess them in all humility and honesty;
3. to be ready to make amends for them;  
to be determined to avoid committing sins in the future, and to live according to God’s will.

In order to do all this, an essential step is to make a **thorough examination of conscience:**

1. becoming aware of the gravity and number of one’s sins, either in thoughts, words or deeds, whether they consist in something wrong that we have committed, or in something good that we should have done and which we failed to do (sins of omission);
2. realizing that, by our sins, we have offended God, have renewed the cause of Jesus Christ’s suffering and death, and caused harm to our neighbor and ourselves.

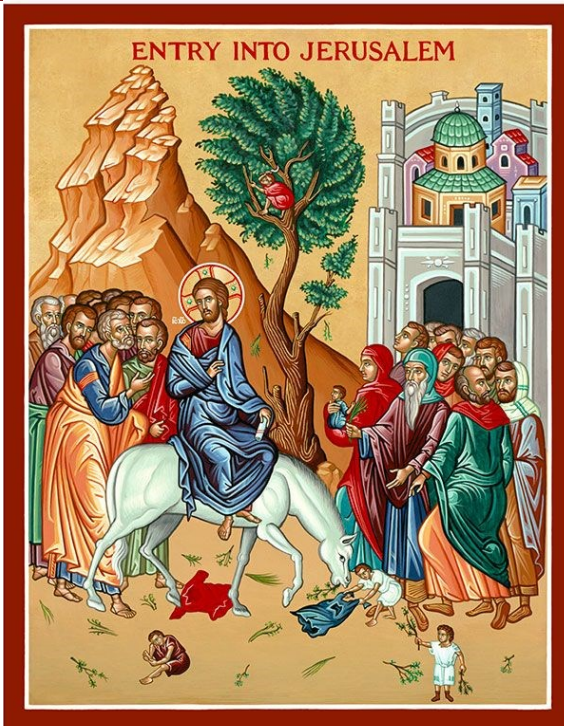
